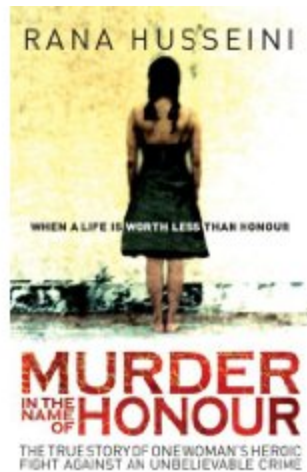

Ms. Husseini is an internationally recognized award-winning journalist and human rights defender. As an investigative journalist for the Jordan Times and a long time civil rights activist, she has intimate knowledge of the laws in the Middle East that allow for little jail time for the family members who kill their women for weak reasons related to the "honor" violated against the family. Activists are attempting to modify these laws at this current time.

Having large international communities in Texas, many victim advocates come across the Honor Killing mindset in their practice. We saw this in the case of YASER ABDEL SAID, the Dallas man that abducted and murdered his daughters on 1/1/08 in an honor killing.
